RE: Charitable Contributions to the Texas State Soil and Water Conservation Board

The Texas State Soil and Water Conservation Board is an agency of the state of Texas, enabled by the Legislature under Title 7, Chapter 201, Subchapter B, of the Texas Agriculture Code.

Chapter 201.023 (d), Texas Agriculture Code states “The State Board may accept any donation or contribution in any form, including money, materials, or services, and from any source for the purpose of carrying out this chapter, including the cost of conducting the annual meeting of conservation district directors.”

The Internal Revenue Service defines a charitable contribution under Title 26, Subtitle A, Subchapter B, Part VI, 170(c) 1, of the U.S. Code as “ A gift to or for the use of a State, a possession of the United States, or any political subdivision of any of the foregoing, or the United States or the District of Columbia, **but only if the contribution or gift is made for exclusively public purposes.**”
